Balvac Undertakes Refurbishment of Birmingham's Flagship City Centre Car Park

Balvac has been awarded a contract worth £660K, by Birmingham City Council, for the refurbishment of their flagship car park at Livery Street, Central Birmingham.

The scheme is part of a larger investment programme for the client, who is planning to refurbish most of their car parks over a three-year period.

Balvac's workscope includes the following:

- Traffic management whilst car park is in use
- Concrete repairs
- White protective coatings to soffits and walls
- Deck waterproofing to all levels
- New lining for Shopmobility bays
- Defined safe pedestrian routes
- Energy efficient new lighting system
- Enhanced CCTV system
- Replacement vehicle barriers and signs

The car park has remained open to the public throughout the works, with no more than 33% of the area being worked on at any one time.

Great care has been taken with setting up safe working areas, protective fencing and temporary signs to minimise disruption to the car park users.

Tremco's high specification deck waterproofing system has been applied to 22,000m² of deck surface, to form bright coloured parking, driving and walking zones.

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
